MOTAT's award winning Pumphouse, built in 1877, is a landmark of Auckland's history, is recognised by the Auckland Council in its District Plan, and is protected as a Class 1 Historic Place.

The Pumphouse and Beam Engine have been fully restored to an operational level. We now need ongoing funding of

approximately \$50,000 per annum to ensure we comply with Heritage regulations and maintain the historical integrity of this iconic building to the highest standard.

Children under 14 must be accompanied by a parent or guardian at all times



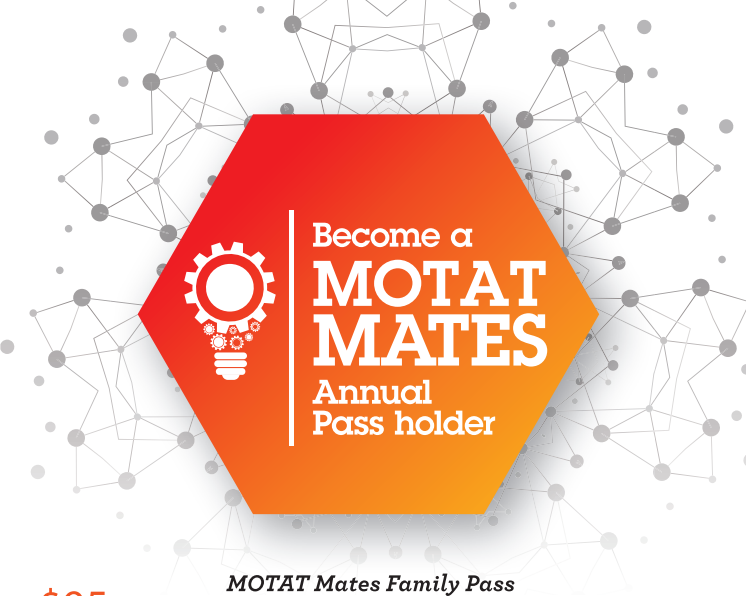
Smoking is not permitted on MOTAT grounds this includes e-cigarettes

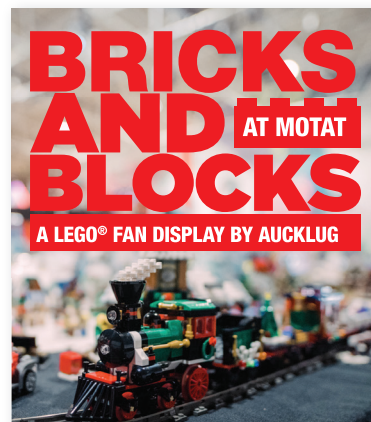


MOTAT DRIVE-IN MOVIE 15 & 16 NOV
